

I hereby respectfully submit for your review a report summarizing the aviation activity at Ben -Gurion International Airport in October 2023.

Since October 7th, Israel has been experiencing a difficult and challenging time, which has also had considerable impacts on civil aviation.

Ben Gurion International Airport is carrying on its operations, maintaining functional continuity and remaining Israel's main entry and exit gate.

During the month, a total of 1,215,956 passengers on 9,578 international and domestic flights passed through Ben-Gurion Airport.

International passenger traffic in October totaled 1,172,435 passengers representing a decrease of 41.25% compared to October 2022.

International aircraft traffic totaled 9,078 flights, representing a decrease of 28.9% compared to October 2022.

International passenger traffic at Terminal 3 this month totaled 1,109,912 passengers. Passengers on International flights from Terminal 1, serving departing passengers only, totaled 62,523.

On domestic flights 43,521 passengers passed through Ben-Gurion Airport this month, compared with 67,353 in October 2022, a decrease of 35.38%.

Israeli airlines carried 644,408 passengers in this month, 54.96% of all travelers passing through Ben - Gurion Airport, an increase of 7.98% relative to the previous October.

The airlines with the highest volume of activity this month are:

EL AL ISRAEL AIRLINES, ISRAIR AIRLINES and ARKIA ISRAELI AIRLINES

The Destination with the highest volume of activity was ATHENS with a total of 84,893 passengers to and from, an increase of 24.78% compared to the previous October.

The country with the highest volume of activity was the GREECE, with 143,414 passengers, constituting 12.23% of all activity.

The countries with the highest volume of activity this month are:

GREECE, UNITED STATES and TURKEY.

The ongoing warfare in the Gaza Strip continues to accompany the State of Israel in November as well.

Ben Gurion International Airport remains operative while maintaining and observing the safety and security of the planes and passengers.

The report's findings reflect the decreased activity in November 2023.

During the month, a total of 425,048 passengers on 4,151 international and domestic flights passed through Ben-Gurion Airport.

International passenger traffic in November totaled 382,081 passengers representing a decrease of 77.77% compared to November 2022.

International aircraft traffic totaled 3,714 flights, representing a decrease of 67.8% compared to November 2022.

On domestic flights 42,967 passengers passed through Ben-Gurion Airport this month, compared with 71,492 in November 2022, a decrease of 39.89%.

Israeli airlines carried 355,047 passengers in this month, 92.92% of all travelers passing through Ben - Gurion Airport, a decrease of 21.46% relative to the previous November.

The airlines which contributed the most to the increase of passenger traffic this month are: EL AL ISRAEL AIRLINES, ISRAIR AIRLINES and ARKIA ISRAELI AIRLINES.

The Destination with the highest volume of activity was NEW YORK - J.F. KENNEDY with a total of 32,187 passengers to and from, a decrease of 40.16% compared to the previous November.

The country with the highest volume of activity was the UNITED STATES, with 76,845 passengers, constituting 20.11% of all activity.
